

RESOLUTION NO. 12-002
SADDLE CREEK COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

A RESOLUTION REVOKING ADOPTION
OF AN ALL-MAILED BALLOT ELECTION

WHEREAS, Saddle Creek Community Services District adopted all-mailed ballot election procedures for conducting the general district election pursuant to Election Code Section 4108; and

WHEREAS, the district elections are held in August of odd numbered years, as elections conducted pursuant to Election Code Section 4108 must be held on the date prescribed in Election Code Section 1500; and

WHEREAS, Election Code Section 10403 requires jurisdictions to file with the Board of Supervisors, and the County Clerk, a resolution requesting consolidation with said election; and

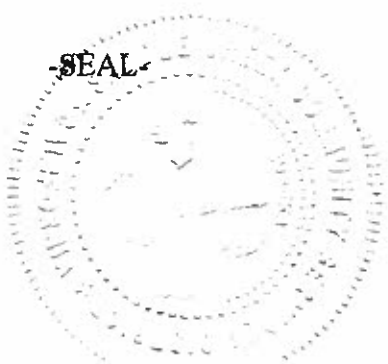
WHEREAS, Election Code Section 4003 allows the district to revoke the adoption of the all-mail ballot procedure; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Saddle Creek Community Services District revokes the adoption of an all-mail ballot election, and the election shall revert back to November of odd numbered years, unless and until there is a consolidation with the general election pursuant to Election Code Section 10404;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the districts election will no longer be held in August of odd numbered years;

THE FOREGOING RESOLUTION was introduced at a regular meeting of the Saddle Creek Community Services District held on November 20, 2012, by Board Member Baker who moved its adoption, which was duly seconded by Board Member Russ and the Resolution was adopted by the following vote:
