Copper Valley Privacy Gate Upgrade Update 10-18-2023

The Copper Valley CSD has identified that the security of the 5-digit code system had been compromised by people putting in random 5-digit codes and gaining access afterhours. To maintain community privacy, the CSD has now replaced and upgraded the old system and removed the five-digit keypad at the front gate to prevent unauthorized nonresidents and guests gaining access into the community.

Copper Valley residents can now use their cell phone or landline telephone to open the gate for guests. **Please see this email for gate form attachment or website for form: https://www.coppervalleycsd.org/files/cb74dccde/NEW+Gate+Access+Form+++++2023.pdf .

During times when the gate is unattended, guests simply call you from the gate's intercom call box, which allows you to then press #9 from your listed cell phone from anywhere in the world through the call box. Please note the new system only allows for **one** registered phone number per resident, this may be a cell phone or a home landline.

In addition to the new upgraded system, any clickers, RFID stickers or proximity cards still work as they did before, there is nothing you need to do with these means of access.
